- 1976 UM establishes satellite campuses at CFB Lahr and CFB Baden in Germany

History – cont.

- 1980s satellite campuses established at bases and stations around Manitoba, and Comox B.C.
- 2006 CFUP ceases to exist and is replaced by the Military Support Office
