MPLAN has an active committee that coordinates workshops, presentations and other networking events to promote fellow members from across Manitoba and showcase their projects and programs.

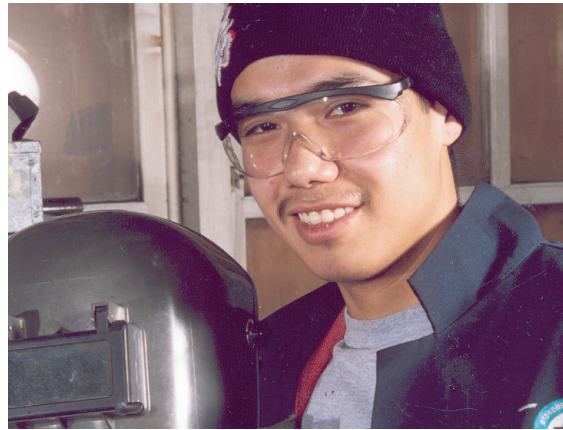
PEARL Award
